Downtown Milford

This self-guided walking tour of downtown Milford's Black Heritage Trail ends with a visit to Bicentennial Park, where the Harriet Wilson Memorial stands. Parking is available in Union Square and on the side streets surrounding "the oval" in Milford center. The walk covers approximately 3.5 miles and takes a little over two hours to complete.
